

OUR CONVICTIONS

We believe that God's infallible Word, as found in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, is the source and norm for all faith and practice in Christ's Church. We hold that Word to be both effective and sufficient for all needs in His service.

SCRIPTURE ALONE

We affirm the inerrant Scripture to be the sole source of written divine revelation, which alone can bind the conscience. The Bible alone teaches all that is necessary for our salvation from sin and is the standard by which all Christian behavior must be measured.

We deny that any creed, council, or individual may bind a Christian's conscience or that the Holy Spirit speaks independently of or contrary to what is set forth in the Bible. 2 Timothy 3:16, 2 Peter

CHRIST ALONE

We reaffirm that our salvation is accomplished by the mediatorial work of the historical Christ alone. His sinless life and substitutionary atonement alone are sufficient for our justification and reconciliation to the Father.

We deny that the Gospel is preached if Christ's substitutionary work is not declared and faith in Christ and his work is not solicited. Romans 5:1-2, Acts 4:12, Romans 5:6-11

GRACE ALONE

We reaffirm that in salvation we are rescued from God's wrath by his grace alone. It is the supernatural work of the Holy Spirit that brings us to Christ by releasing us from our bondage to sin and raising us from spiritual death to spiritual life.

We deny that salvation is in any sense a human work. Human methods, techniques or strategies by themselves cannot accomplish this transformation. Faith is not produced by our undegenerated human nature. Ephesians 2:8-9

FAITH ALONE

We reaffirm that justification is by grace alone through faith alone because of Christ alone. In justification Christ's righteousness is imputed to us as the only possible satisfaction of God's perfect justice.

We deny that justification rests on any merit to be found in us, or upon the ground of an infusion of Christ's righteousness in us, or that an institution claiming to be a church that denies or condemns faith alone can be recognized as a legitimate church. Romans 5:1-2

TO GOD BE THE GLORY

We reaffirm that because salvation is of God and has been accomplished by God, it is for God's glory and that we must glorify Him always. We must live our entire lives before the face of God, under the authority of God and for His glory alone.

We deny that we can properly glorify God if our worship is confused with entertainment, if we neglect either Law or Gospel and our preaching, or if self-improvement, self-esteem or self-fulfillment are allowed to become alternatives to the gospel. 1 Corinthians 10:31-33

Dear God, I agree this day that I am a sinful person, deserving of hell and now believe that only Jesus who is God in human flesh can change my heart and save me from my sinful way of life and future punishment in hell, as He is the ONLY Savior given to mankind.
